Prospective Business Majors:

Students seeking admission to business programs will be classified as pre-accounting, pre-business, or pre-economics majors until they qualify for admission to an upper division major. In order to qualify for an upper division major, students must:

- A. Attain junior standing (complete 60 semester hours of credit)
- B. Complete the following seven progression courses at a NC Community College with a minimum grade of C in each course.
 1. ACC 120
 2. ACC 121
 3. ECO 251
 4. ECO 252
 5. MAT 263 or MAT 271
 6. MAT 151 or MAT 155
 7. CIS 110
 - Note: Students may attempt each of the seven progression courses listed a maximum of two times.
- C. Students must earn at least a 2.5 GPA in the seven progression courses, as well as attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.
