*Licensure to teach in the following areas of Secondary education (9-12): Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, Comprehensive Science, English, History, Comprehensive Social Studies, Mathematics, and Physics

*Licensure to teach in the following areas of K-12 education: French, German, Spanish, Art, Dance, Music, and Theatre

Admission into Teacher Education Programs:

1. Attain a “C” or higher in EDUC 2100 and SPED 2100 (or MDSK 2100 for 9-12 Secondary Education minors ONLY).
2. Complete Praxis I (www.ets.org) with passing scores: Reading 176, Writing 173, and Math 173
OR qualify for an exemption by having earned:
 - A total score of 1100 on the SAT – exempts you from Praxis I
 - A composite score of 24 on the ACT – exempts you from Praxis I
 - A 550 Math SAT or 24 Math ACT score – exempts you from the Math portion of Praxis I
 - A 550 Critical Reading/Verbal SAT or 24 English ACT score – exempts you from the Reading and Writing portion of the Praxis I
3. Attain an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher in at least 45 semester hours of higher education course work.
4. Advisor’s Recommendation
5. Departmental Approval
